Requests to be excused from an examination: See College of Law Rules, [Section 7.02](#).

The following are the only grounds on which a student may request to be excused from an examination:

- a) The student has two examinations scheduled to begin on the same day; or
- b) An emergency has arisen; or
- c) It has become impossible or impracticable for the student to take the examination at the scheduled time; or
- d) The student has three in a row in the first week, or four exams in a row in the same week.

The student must request the excused absence and consult with the Associate Dean prior to the examination, or if prior consultation is not possible, then as soon as possible following the examination. The Associate Dean must discuss the request with the instructor involved. It is within the Dean's discretion to grant or deny the request.
